announces the competition for the postdoctoral position
in the field of Synthesis and Studies of Organic Optoelectronic Materials
with the rank of Assistant Professor (M/F) or Assistant Researcher (M/F)

at the Centre for Organic and Nanohybrid Electronics (CONE)
on the Silesian University of Technology in Gliwice, 2A Akademicka St.

Job Description:

We seek for outstanding and enthusiastic researchers with strong expertise in the synthesis and characterization of organic/organometallic compounds (ideally, π -functional compounds for electronic/optoelectronic applications), and a proven record of high quality research and achievements, to be a part of interdisciplinary research team on development of photo/electroactive organic π -functional molecules as materials for optoelectronics. The successful candidates will work in the group of Prof. Igor Perepichka on the NCN (Narodowe Centrum Nauki, Poland) OPUS project toward development of novel semiconductive and light-emitting molecules based on azatriangulene core and related structures.

Terms and Conditions of Employment:

- 1) Persons, who meet the requirements specified in the Act of 20 July 2018 on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668, as amended) and the Statute of the Silesian University of Technology of 3 June, 2019 (Legal Monitor of SUT of 2020, item 339) may enter the competition for the position of assistant professor.
- 2) Estimated work commencement date: **immediately**.
- 3) Workplace: Centre for Organic and Nanohybrid Electronics (CONE), group of Prof. Igor F. Perepichka. Position is related to a research project financed by the National Science Centre, Poland, no. 2023/51/B/ST5/03009, entitled *Novel Azatriangulenes as Electron Donor and Electron Acceptor C₃-Symmetry Cores for Design of π -Functional Materials in Organic Electronics*.
- 4) Contract type: fixed term, full-time job, available immediately; minimum 6 months with the possibility for an extension up to 22 months, although the employment must end no later than 29/07/2028 (subject successful initial 6-months probation period).

- 5) Rank of an employment: Assistant Professor (M/F) or Assistant Researcher (M/F), depending on qualification.
- 6) Number of vacancies: 2.
- 7) Remuneration: PLN 11,660 gross per month (the amount includes all the employer's and employee's costs (employer's contributions to healthcare, pension, etc.), as well as additional annual salary) which is up to total PLN 140,000 per year.

Main Tasks and Key Responsibilities:

- 1) Design and synthesis of organic π -functional molecules. Developmnet of synthetic strategies to the target compounds.
- 2) Characterization of redox-active and photoactive π -functional materials using the basic set of instrumental techniques: NMR spectroscopy (including solid-state), MS, FTIR, ESR, UV-Vis, photoluminescence and an involvement in other studies (electrochemistry, spectroelectrochemistry, Raman spectroscopy, XRD, DSC/TGA, electron microscopy and other methods).
- 3) Participate actively in other research and development activities on new electronic materials.
- 4) Preparation of proper records and database on performed experiments and measurements and their analysis.
- 5) Writing original research articles and reviews for publication, with a focus on publishing research results in leading journals in the field.
- 6) Involvement in grant proposal preparation.
- 7) Develop project plan and execute scientific programme in a timely manner.
- 8) Reporting the progress of research to Prof. Igor F. Perepichka.
- 9) To be involved in mentoring and training PhD students in the group.
- 10) Provide guidance, mentor and training to working team and regular review of needs to ensure proficiency of the team.
- 11) Assist in organizing other academic activities for the project (e.g., academic speeches, conferences, meetings, publicity etc);
- 12) Other academic and managing tasks assigned by the PI.

Qualifications & Prerequisites:

- 1) PhD degree in Chemistry or an equivalent level of professional qualification and experience are essential.
- 2) Well versed with methods of modern organic and physical organic chemistry.
- 3) Candidates should have confirmed research experience and strong background in organic synthesis and common methods of characterisations of organic compounds (NMR, MS, FTIR, UV-Vis, HPLC etc).
- 4) Experience in physical methods of characterisation and studies of organic molecular and/or polymeric materials for electronics, and DFT calculations are desirable and would be an advantage.
- 5) Strong publication records relevant to organic chemistry and/or materials science.
- 6) Highly motivated researcher with strong interest in pursuing research in experimental organic materials chemistry.
- 7) Ability to resolve complex issues and make technical, and procedural decisions and judgments
- 8) An ability to work independently and as part of a multi-disciplinary team.
- 9) An ability to work under high pressure in a tight-time schedule.
- 10) Good writing skills for scientific articles.
- 11) Good interpersonal/communication skills and high level of English proficiency (both spoken and written).
- 12) Adhere to high ethical standards.

Additional Requirements (Desirable Skills):

- 1) Previous postdoctoral (post-PhD) research in other Universities or R&D experience in industry is a plus.
- 2) Research grant writing skills.
- 3) Familiarity with and/or experience in the related fields of optoelectronic materials and devices.
- 4) Industrial experience or collaboration with industry.
- 5) International experience at universities abroad.

Benefits:

- 1) Full-time employment contract with the rank of Assistant Professor or Assistant Researcher position (depending on the qualification) at the Centre for Organic and Nanohybrid Electronics (CONE);
- 2) Favourable financial conditions: internationally competitive salary commensurate with qualification and experience, in line with NCN salary scale for postdoctoral researchers.
- 3) Work in the interdisciplinary team on organic electronic materials
- 4) Work in a friendly and supportive environment that cares about the employee's quality of life.

Prospects for Professional Development:

- 1) Work in reputable international research team.
- 2) Developmental research topics with a large impact on science.
- 3) Joint interdisciplinary research involving the acquisition of skills in other areas.

4. A brief research statement regarding the past and present research (2-3 pages).
5. Copies of at least three the most important publications.
6. Copies of PhD / MSc / BSc diplomas or equivalents.
7. Candidate's declaration that the Silesian University of Technology will be the primary place of work.
8. Consent for processing personal data of the candidate expressed as "I consent to the use of my personal data by the Silesian University of Technology for the purpose of processing my job application".
